WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners on the 4th day of March 1974 approved a Resolution declaring that the public health convenience and necessity required the establishment of an improvement district within Grand County, Utah and · WHEREAS the County Commissioners of Grand County published notice of intention to establish an improvement district including the area described in said notice and to be known as the Spanish Valley Water and

Sewer Improvement District, and

WHEREAS said notice provided that a public hearing be held on the 8th day of April 1974 at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M. in the Board room in the Court House in Moab, Utah at which time all interested parties may appear before the board to be heard either in support of or in opposition to the proposed improvement district, and

WHEREAS said notice was published in the Times Independent, a weekly newspaper of general circulation for four successive weeks beginning on the 14th day of March 1974 and ending on the 4th day of April 1974, and

WHEREAS on the 8th day of April 1974, said public hearing was held, and after investigation and consideration of all the circumstances the Board of County Commissioners has determined that the public health, convenience and necessity require the creation of the Spanish Valley Water and Sewer Improvement District in order to provide for water and sewer and preserve the health, promote the prosperity, improve the morals, peace and order, comfort and convenience of Grand County, State of Utah, and the inhabitants thereof and in order to carry into effect the provisions of chapter 6, title 17, Utah Code Anni (ated 1953, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, and good cause appearing the Board of County Commissioners of Grand County, adopt an Ordinance as follows:

1. There is hereby established and created under Chapter 6, Title 17, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, the Spanish Valley Water and Sewer Improvement District, which district shall include all the property and lands described in the notice of intention to establish the Spanish Valley Water and Sewer Improvement District within Grand County, published in the Times Independent on March 14th, March 21st, March 28th and April 1974.

- 2. All the functions, activities, and responsibilities of the Spanish Valley Water and Sewer Improvement District shall be preforme and carried out in accordance with and subject to Chapter 6, Title 17, Una Code Annotated 1953, as amended, and other applicable law.
